

## MINOR IN ECONOMIC POLICY REQUIREMENTS FORM

### 21 total credits required

The Economic Policy minor is available to non-ECON and non-FIEC majors. Students may not receive more than one minor from the Department of Economics. Some of the courses required for the minor have prerequisites that are not listed here. A grade of “C” or better is required in each course to fulfill minor requirements.
